







PIN HIKE - PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT

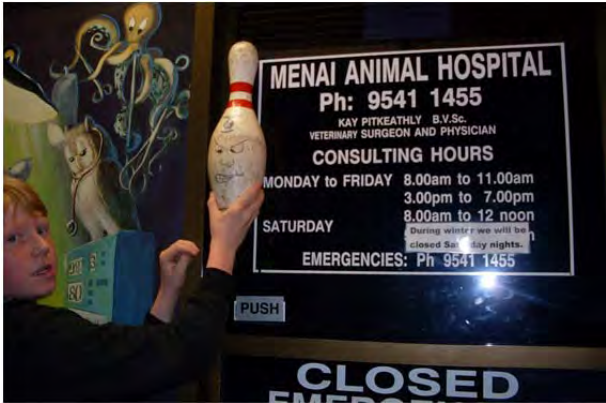

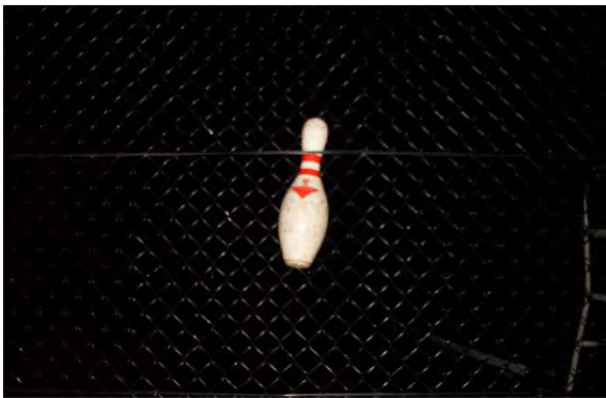
Clue 15 – your pin is on the other side of a locked gate
